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### The First Solo Classical and Jazz Competition Rules and Regulations

 All applications must be submitted by Friday, March 15, 2019 at 5:00pm via email or mail with your selected solo piece and accompaniment

- There are two competition levels per Category: 6-8<sup>th</sup> and 9-12<sup>th</sup>
- Selected pieces should fall in between Grades 1 2/2.5 for 6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> graders and 2.5 4 for 9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> graders
- Students will be judged by the attached rubric
- If student chooses to start over 2 pts will be deducted from their final score (if more than half of the piece has been played the student will not be allowed to start over)
- In case of a tie, the highest score from the Category of Technique/Melodic Interpretation will determine the winner
- Students can participate in both categories
- Classical Piece/Movement of a Concerto/Sonata shall not exceed 8 minutes (if the student goes beyond the 8 minutes one point will be deducted for every minute over the 8 minutes)
- Jazz Selection: Head should be played twice; solo for two choruses and then the head back out (If the selection head is long i.e. (*Desafinado*) then the head would be played once with an option for improvising for two choruses) Jazz performance *shall not* exceed 4 minutes (if the student goes beyond the 4 minutes one point will be deducted for every minute over the 4 minutes)



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#### **Rules and Regulations page 2**

#### **Accompaniment:**

- All Classical Selections should have accompaniment unless otherwise stated by the composer. (If accompaniment is needed please specify in the comments section of the application). At least one rehearsal with the accompanists will be provided by VIDE. Email the music with the application
  - \* you can however provide your own accompanist \*
- 2. Jazz accompaniment will be provided. Please make sure to indicate the key, tempo, and style of your selection. Students must play the head two times, improvise on two choruses and play the head out one final time. Email the lead sheet in concert pitch with the application.

#### Attire:

Students are to be in full uniform or adequate attire (button down or polo shirts, long pants/skirts/dresses (below the knees). No jeans, nothing tight/sagging/revealing
 \*we encourage wearing your school uniform \*

#### **Attendance:**

- 1. Students are to be at the designated competition venue two hours prior to their performance time. A schedule will be sent out at least a week prior to the competition as to time slots slated for each student.
- 2. Students are required to remain at the competition until the end for presentations and awards.
